## What is Youth Employment Service, Y.E.S.?

The Camarillo Youth Employment Service program assists youth 14-21 find employment within the community. It is a great matching service that is beneficial for not only the youth of Camarillo but for local business and individuals that may need assistance at their residence.

### Provides free assistance to youth by:

- Matching youth job placement needs with employers based on hiring requirements and applicant qualifications.
- Helping youth develop the effective job search skills necessary to succeed in the current labor market.
- Youth may participate in the Boys and Girls Club of Camarillo Job Ready and Career Launch programs ages 14-18. These nationally recognized programs teach youth about all aspects of finding, getting and keeping that job.

### Provides free assistance to employers by:

- Referring potential employees to both private residents and business employers for permanent, part-time or full-time employment opportunities.
- Referring potential employees to temporary or “one-time only” requests for both private residents and commercial businesses.
- Pre-screening job applicants to match employers’ hiring requirements.

### Special note to parents!

Parents are to report suspicious activity promptly to the proper authorities and to Y.E.S.
